A Message from our Director:

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

September is always an exciting time at Calvary Rescue Mission as we start a new round of classes for those men who are interested. One night a week we have a team of volunteers who lead our Discipleship I class. It is designed to help those in the class better understand what it means to follow Christ using a workbook and group discussion. One afternoon each week we offer Discipleship II. This course is open to those who have completed Discipleship I and are ready to draw even closer to our Lord. They have a lesson each session and keep a daily prayer journal and reading journal. They also memorize the books of the Bible and key verses to lead someone into a relationship with Jesus. They also have to develop and give their short testimony. On another night of the week we offer our Addiction Recovery Program, led by a certified drug and alcohol counselor. Then, on a separate night, we offer a "Faith and Finance" class. This helps the men learn how to manage their money Biblically. Many of our men have never had a bank account or written a check or learned how to develop a budget. This class is led by a facilitator along with assistants, known as Allies, who help the men understand each concept. These are all good classes and many of the men get excited about learning more about their Lord.

Jimmy Seeley's academic and career accomplishments are incredible. He graduated from the University of Memphis with a Bachelor's in Business Administration in 1992 and then graduated again from the University of Memphis with his Jurius Doctorate (JD) in 2002. Jimmy was baptized as a baby and went through a confirmation class as a teenager, but he never actually came to know Jesus as his personal Lord and Savior until he was 34. He was about to be a father and would soon be the father to two daughters but he did not like the man he was and was concerned about the example he would be setting for his child. He felt apathetic toward God, he turned to alcohol during difficult times, and he recognized that if he didn't know his Heavenly Father, he would not be a good earthly

father. He was convicted of this realization by the power of the Holy Spirit, he repented, ran to Jesus, and was saved and baptized! Shortly after his salvation, Jimmy landed an incredible high-level job at St. Jude's downtown! Life was going well, but as you all know, life isn't always fair and isn't always easy. After working for 10 years at St. Jude, his position was eliminated out of nowhere and he was laid off. He spent the next year looking for work. Despite awesome academic credentials, he struggled finding work. This brought a terrible amount of stress on Jimmy and his family, and he began falling back into alcohol to cope. He finally landed another job and spent 7 years there before being laid off again without notice, and during this time was going through a divorce. Between another layoff and an impending divorce, Jimmy hit rock bottom. He had to leave the family house because of the divorce and began sleeping in motels and even his car for a period of time. He struggled with severe depression and even thoughts of suicide. Jimmy explains that he felt the Lord's presence in a powerful way once he finally hit rock bottom. The Lord began to rebuild his life. He rediscovered his love for Jesus, began reading his Bible, and put down the bottle. By God's grace, Jimmy has been sober for the last year, he has been a part of a morning prayer group once a week, and has enjoyed being a client at Calvary Rescue Mission for the last couple of months. His daughters are so proud of him, and he is so proud of his daughters. Jimmy has found great friends among the clients and staff at Calvary and has appreciated the stability that Calvary has given him. He knows where he will sleep every night, he gets delicious meals each day, and is in a safe environment where he can grow in his walk with Jesus. He is currently pursuing employment opportunities and would appreciate your prayers and any contacts you might be able to send his way.

Sammie Armstead has a unique relationship with Calvary Rescue Mission. He is the only one who has served the men at the mission in every possible role. Sammie first came to Calvary as a homeless man who had been living on the streets and sleeping under bridges and overpasses. Soon, he was asked to serve as a staff member and he gladly started working for us. Sammie served both as a cook and as supervisor. He eventually got a job with Corky's, got married and moved into his own house.

Even though he was no longer staying at Calvary Rescue Mission, Sammie still wanted to serve the men who live here. He served many years on our Board of Directors but has now moved into Director Emeritus status. Having served as a client and as a staff member, Sammie gave other board members great insight into things that were needed at the mission. Sammie's greatest impact, however, has been his many years of faithful attendance as lay preacher on the first Wednesday night of every month. He also attends on the second Wednesday night every month to support another pastor and encourage the men. Sammie's call to ministry has even carried him outside the walls of Calvary Rescue Mission in ministering to the homeless. For many years, Sammie and his wife, Betty, conducted their "Church Without Doors" in Beale Street Park on Sunday afternoons. They used 5-gallon buckets and lumber to form benches for the people to sit while Sammie preached God's Word and Betty led them in song. They also fed those who attended and provided them some clean clothes if they needed them. Sammie Armstead is truly a unique individual and a blessing to Calvary Rescue Mission in so many ways.
